RECOMMENDATION:

City Council consider the cancellation of the regularly scheduled City Council meeting of November 4, 2014.

BACKGROUND:

November 4, 2014 is the date of the General Municipal Election at which time the electorate will consider a City ballot measure, City advisory measure and two City Council seats. Additionally, the electorate will also be considering Congressional, State Assembly, Senate and County seats and numerous State initiatives. Staff is suggesting that the meeting be cancelled so as not to conflict with the election.

ANALYSIS:

The City Council has the legal authority to establish meeting dates and times and to cancel such meetings with proper and timely public notice. Such a change is not significant as long as the decision to cancel the meeting date is done well in advance to allow staff enough time to place items either on the previous meeting agenda of October 21, 2014 or the following meeting of November 18, 2014.

ALTERNATIVES:

The City Council may choose not to cancel the November 4, 2014 meeting.

FISCAL REVIEW:

There is no fiscal impact to this item.
